





Thin with Interlux #333 thinner, to the consistency of thick paint. The Natural is an uncolored base which will appear gold after about 8 coats of varnish. Use on Capri, Riviera and Continental king planks. Mahogany stain also attains the correct color after varnishing. Before staining, mahogany should be sanded with 100 grit paper. Finer paper would cause blotchy staining. If you use coarser paper, the boat will stain too dark. Filler stain is part of the secret for that extra smooth finish you want. Using the wrong color stain on a Chris-Craft will devalue the boat significantly.



Use a bristle brush, foam brushes will disturb your stain. Don't sand between coats of sealer. One or two coats is sufficiant. This is not the same as thinned out varnish. The solvent is NAPTHA, Maximum ventilation and a protective mask is a must.

# EPIFANES & GLOSS VARNISH



TIPS!

RELIABLE ADVICE IS FREE... DON'T RESTORE FIRST AND ASK QUESTIONS LATER! We answer questions every day for amateur restorers. Your boat can and should look as good as a professionally done boat!

BLISTERING Causes: A) The application of varnish over a surface containing excessive moisture or solvent. B) Inadequate film thickness, permitting moisture to pass through. C) Varnishing on a sun heated surface, trapping air as it expands out of the pores of the wood, or moving the work out into the sun just after varnishing. D) Sometimes a varnish which dries too quickly will trap its own volatile agents in the film. Cure: sand and refinish.

**BLOOMING** A whitesh appearance on the varnished surface caused by the finish absorbing moisture while drying.

CHECKING Shallow hairline cracks which develop in varnish due to uneven shrinkage through the cross section of the film layers. Causes: A) Insufficient drying time between coats. B) Excessive heavy coats. C) Adding wrong materials to varnish. D) Recoating a previously checked surface. Cure: sand down through the checked layers.

**CRAWLING** The material appears to creep away from certain spots, leaving them uncoated. Causes: water, low temperature, excessive viscosity, grease, wax, silicone, unsanded surfaces.

CRYSTALIZING Rough surface caused by lack of fresh circulating air, gas fumes which reduce the oxygen content of the air, or by a cold draft blowing on the film before it is dry.

**DULLED FINISH** Imperfectly dried undercoats, porous undercoats, excessive thinning of varnish, exposure to dew or moisture while still wet. Hint: do not varnish at the end of the day, as dew may form as the temperature drops during the night.

LIFTING When a finishing coat, being applied over another coat, softens and raises the undercoat in irregular wrinkles. this effect is also known as "raising". Caused by too short a drying time between coats, the use of too strong solvents in the top coat, or use of a top coat that is incompatible with lower coats and acts like a paint remover.


**ORANGE PEEL** When a sprayed finish does not level out. Caused by under reduction, wrong solvent, too rapid drying, improper air pressure.

# BADGER HAIR VARNISH BRUSH,

No matter how diligently a brush has been cleaned, if it has been used for painting, it should not be used for varnishing. Small particles of paint will flow out of the brush.

Also, one a varnish brush has been used, it should never be allowed to dry. Suspend it in mineral spirits, being careful that the bristles do not touch the bottom of the container. It will have to be airtight, or the mineral spirits will quickly evaporate.




SURFACE PREPARATION Begin sanding mahogany with an 18 inch sanding board and 80 grit paper, finish with 100 grit. Finer paper will not leave enough surface texture to fill with filler stain. An air file will get the job done the fastest, fairing out wavy or gouged planks remarkably well, but must be handled carefully, or damage will result just as quickly. These units run about \$130. Do not sand with a disc sander, a belt sander or an orbital finishing sander. You need the long block to get a level finish.

STAINING Use the correct color filler stain for your model boat. Filler stain is a thick paste and is thinned with mineral spirits prior to use. Paint it on thickly and quickly, there is no need to rub it in. It may take two people to do this quickly enough. Try to stain one whole side of the boat before the stain starts to dry. It will begin to have a dull look in spots as it sets up. Rub with burlap: one person rubbing vigorously with the saturated pieces of burlap, and a second person, rubbing very lightly, following behind with fresh pieces of burlap to pick up the excess. If you allow it to become dry, it will be very difficult to rub out.

SEALING Allow the stain to dry 3-4 days before sealing. Seal with a sanding sealer, such as Pettit #2018 Clear Sealer, or with varnish thinned 50%. We prefer the 2018 sealer, which has a naptha (lighter fluid!) base. Don't use near a flame. This product is hazardous to your health and you MUST WEAR A NEW MASK. and have MAXIMUM VENTILATION. Apply two coats. Don't use a sponge brush, it will disturb the stain. Just slop it on like water, don't worry about runs. Do not sand between coats.

VARNISHING When applying Epifanes varnish over existing varnish or urethane, wash the old surface down with soap and water before sanding. Wash with large amounts of denatured alcohol and clean rags between every coat. Do not wipe down with mineral spirits, as it will dull the finish. Sweep your varnishing room the day before, allowing time for dust to settle. Hose the room down before varnishing, being carefull not to wet the boat. Your boat builds up a negative charge when you stroke with the varnish brush, this attracts the positively charged dust particles in the air. Spray your clothing and any plastic tent material with "Static Guard". Don't varnish on a windy day. When brushing Epifanes varnish: thin 1st coat 50%. 2nd coat 25%, 3rd coat 15%, and additional coats 0-7%. If you used sealer, thin your 1st coat of varnish 25%. Load the brush with just enough varnish for one stroke. Trust the flowing capability of Epifanes varnish, the brush marks and bubbles will flow out. The most glossy finish will be achieved by a minimum of brush strokes. Do not wipe the brush against the side of the can, as this will introduce air bubbles into your work. When varnishing very large surfaces, you may use Epifanes Stunt Oil to extend the wet edge time.

SANDING: Sand 1st coat of varnish with 120 grit paper, sand 2nd - 6th coat with 180 grit paper, sand 7th - 8th coat with 220 grit, and 9th - 12th coat with 280 grit. You should use 12 coats of Epifanes varnish for good protection against the ultra-violet rays from the sun. If you try to get by with only 4 or 5 coats of varnish, the sun will penetrate to the lowest layer and lift it. If your boat gets a lot of use, you will need fresh coats of varnish every couple years to maintain U.V. protection.

You need at least 12 coats to get good U.V. protection. If you try to get by with fewer coats, you may have lifting and flaking after one summer in the sun. If you use Pettit #2018 Clear Sealer over fresh stain, then only thin the first coat of varnish 25%

# **EPIFANES BRUSHING THINNER**

A pure white spirit for thinning Epifanes varnish. Do not use mineral spirits, it will dull your finish. You will need 2-3 liters per case of varnish. Liter \$7.50

#### SANDING BOARD

You should NOT be using an electric finishing sander on your wood hull. A finishing sander will leave a wavy surface that is noticeable after varnishing. Start stripping with Dayco Marine Stripper and a scraper. Then get the remaining stain out of the grain with a brass bristle pot-scrubber brush and more Dayco Stripper. The brush can be found at many grocery stores. Do not begin sanding until the wood is completely clean.

Start sanding the wood with 80 grit paper, finish with 100 grit. Finer paper will not leave enough texture to fill with filler stain. 3M GOLD is a high quality paper that outlasts other types and resists loading.

# **HOW TO PAINT YOUR BOAT:**

BARE PLYWOOD: Sand with 80 grit, seal with #2018 sealer. BARE WOOD: Sand with 80 grit... OLD PAINT: Sand with 120 grit...

Then... fill gouges 1/8 to 1/4" with surfacing putty (page 3). Sand with 120 grit. Apply 1st coat #4279. Sand with 120. Apply 2nd coat #4279 if needed. Sand with 220 grit. Apply enamel. Sand with 220 grit. Apply 2nd coat of enamel.

Valve seats, stems and guides, top cylinder walls and rings in automotive and marine engines are not adequately lubricated by crank case oil. By removing the lead from gasoline we have eliminated all of its lubricating properties.

Various products on the market are promoted as upper-engine lubricants, but unfortunately burn at a temperature lower than the engine's normal operating temperature.
